

Initial Statement of Petition Insufficiency

I, Heidi Leatherwood, City Clerk for the City of Greeley, Colorado, do hereby certify that the referendum petition to repeal Ordinance 30-2025 received October 16, 2025, has been examined and appears to be initially **insufficient**. The examination brought forth the following findings:

- 1. The Petition was filed with the City Clerk on **September 29, 2025**, within 30 days of the passage of the ordinance (GMC § 2-84(c)).
- 2. The Petition was in the required form as supplied by the City Clerk [GMC § 2-85(a)].
- 3. The Petition contained **197** petition sections.
- 4. Total signatures required based on 10% of total vote in 2024 general election (GMC §2-84(c)) was **4586 signatures**.
- 5. The petition was examined by comparing information on signature lines against a list of registered electors (GMC § 2-87) with the following results:
