



Initial Statement of Petition Sufficiency

I, Heidi Leatherwood, City Clerk for the City of Greeley, Colorado, do hereby certify that the initiative petition to repeal Ordinance 15-2025 received August 6, 2025, has been examined and appears to be initially sufficient. The examination brought forth the following findings:

1. The Petition was filed with the City Clerk on **August 6, 2025**, 90 days prior to the November 4, 2025, general election [G.M.C. § 2-83(c)], and contained 218 sections.
Note: There were 16 petition sections determined to be invalid due to incomplete circulator affidavits which included 547 signatures.
2. The Petition **was in the required form** as supplied by the City Clerk [CRS 31-10-302(1)].
3. Signatures required for petition sufficiency were based on 10% of voters participating in the 2024 general election [G.M.C. § 2-83(c)] equaling **4586 signatures**.
4. The petition was examined by comparing information on signature lines against a list of registered electors [CRS 31-10-302(2)-(4)] with the following results:
