

Need Help with Small Indoor or Outdoor Tasks?

The City of Greeley's **Neighbor Labor** program may be able to help.

Neighbor Labor connects eligible residents with temporary assistance for small outdoor tasks that support health, safety and neighborhood care.



Examples of tasks may include:

- Basic yard cleanup
- Branch, leaf and light debris removal
- Lawn trimming
- Weed removal
- Snow removal
- Other small outdoor maintenance needs, as capacity allows

Who may qualify?

Residents may qualify due to:

- Age
- Disability
- Temporary injury
- Other qualifying circumstances
