109.00 COMMAND PROTOCOL

109.01 Authority of Command:

- The authority of command at any police incident will comply with the Code of Conduct, Chapter V, Article 5.4. In certain circumstances delineated by directive, this authority may be delegated to lower levels of the command structure of the Department. This delegation will be accomplished by General Order or Department Manuals and within the parameters of specific police command situations.
- Outside of the Police Departments' Front Desk normal business hours, Monday-Friday 7:30 a.m.to 5:30 p.m., the Watch Commander is the ranking police official on duty and as such is responsible for police service provided to the citizens of Greeley. Commensurate with this responsibility, the Watch Commander may move to correct deficiencies immediately as necessary. If this action involves sections normally outside the Patrol Division, the Watch Commander shall prepare documentation for the action taken and forward it to the appropriate Commander(s) via the chain of command.
- In special circumstances requiring a task force composed of two or more subdivisions of the Department, the Deputy Chief responsible for the resolution of the special circumstance shall designate one individual to direct the activities of the task force.
