Campaign Finance Contribution Adjustments

Effective Date: April 1, 2025

Pursuant to Greeley Municipal Code Section 2-126(d), the City Clerk is required to adjust the election-cycle limits on municipal campaign contribution limits at the first quarter of 2025 and every two years thereafter. The City Clerk is required to specify the adjusted limits in rules promulgated by the City Clerk. The City Clerk therefore promulgates this Administrative Rule.

The municipal campaign contribution limits contained in Greeley Municipal Code Section 2-126 are adjusted as follows:

(a) For any particular election cycle, no person shall make contributions, including contributions in-kind, to a candidate and/or committee (as the term is used in Colo. Const. Art. XXVIII, §§2(3), (10), (12), and (14)) that, in the aggregate, exceed the following amounts: Councilmember \$2,555.00; Mayor \$2,555.00.

The adjusted amounts are calculated using the following formula:

- Formula: (Current contribution limit (\$2500.00) x (Two-year percentage change in CPI(2.27%) = Amount of increase(\$56.75) rounded to the nearest lowest \$5.00
- Two-year percentage change in CPI: 2.27%.

The next adjustment will be made on April 1, 2027.
